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Hi Pete -

In quizzing the various project managers for the projects, all of the projects are fully funded to date.

The Fire Station ended up having a total cost of approximately \$750,000 that was entirely funded by the Rancho Bernardo (RB) DIF. This project is complete.

The Sports Field Lighting is a new project with a budgeted amount of \$700,000 and to date is fully funded with RB DIF funds. Once the project goes to bid, we will know more about the \$700,000 budget and if it is the correct amount or not.

The two traffic signals each have a total budget of \$270,000 per signal. For each signal, \$200,000 of RB DIF monies has been appropriated, and the remaining funding of \$70,000 per signal is scheduled to come from Transnet. Please note that you will not see the Transnet funding on the attached CIP sheets, but the project manager did indicate that the funding will be from Transnet. The sidewalk improvements at Camino Del Norte are fully funded and the improvement is complete. In talking with the project manager, the DIF funding of \$100,000 was not fully exhausted and those monies can be returned to the RB DIF fund balance. The process to close out the project and return the funds to the fund balance will take some time.
