

Page 3-39 Figure 3-54 shows the alignments in this subsection south of Escondido.

The design shown...depicts an alignment with a design speed of 150 mph. It is generally in an aerial configuration on the side of the freeway, because it is difficult to try to locate columns within the freeway cross section. A slower design speed would allow the alignment to follow the freeway closer and reduce impacts. A higher design speed would likely require tunneling. Further coordination is needed with Caltrans and the City of San Diego in this area.

Study in 2007 indicated too little traffic. Study in 2010 indicated too much traffic. Residents feel the road is extremely dangerous, due to the excessive speed of vehicles.
