South Segment: Pomerado Road Construction Advisory #1

Northbound Interstate 15 On-Ramp from Westbound Pomerado Road Temporarily Closed for 20 Days

Please be advised that the on-ramp to northbound Interstate 15 (I-15) from westbound Pomerado Road will be closed to traffic for 20 days starting July 7. This temporary closure is necessary to widen the freeway and reconstruct the on-ramp as part of the ongoing I-15 Express Lanes Project. Motorists trying to access northbound I-15 will be detoured to Mira Mesa Boulevard. Detour signs will be in place to direct motorists.

Reconstruction of this ramp will complete the ramp work on the west side of the Miramar Road/Pomerado Road overpass. This portion of construction is part of constructing the South Segment of the I-15 Express Lanes project. The South Segment will cost approximately \$481 million. Once completed in 2012, there will be seven northbound and seven southbound general purpose lanes in addition to four express lanes in the median of the freeway at Miramar Road/Pomerado Road.
