A. <u>CIP LIST – crucially needed for the CIP Budget, FY13/14,</u> we are to choose 5 priority projects from our community. Reynaldo lead the discussion.

Presentation:

- The Mayor's office wants to get a list from each community with 5 priorities for each community. The CPC has asked each Planning Group to develop its own list.
- > There is a list that has been compiled for the Development Impact Fees (DIF).
- > Even ADA improvements are unfunded.
- > Villa Montezuma money has been spent in studies and Engineering proposals by the City.

The City has not taken the required actions. We may lose the CCDC money so let's make that the number one priority (so we do not lose the money).

- > Angled parking on Imperial Avenue, from 19th to 32nd Streets.
 - 1. Complete the renovation project for the Villa Montezuma.
 - 2. Traffic controls at:
 - Oceanview and the Home Depot development (Market Place); San Pascual; upgrade of traffic signal (on the list as part of others City-wide). These traffic controls are directly across from ECC and improve street illumination, and "pedestrian safety zone markings" in the same area;
 - 3. Signalization at 29th and Oceanview was recommended;
 - 4. Willie Henderson Sports Complex needs to upgrade sport field and parking lot lights, LEDs should be seriously considered;
 - 5. We should emphasize Project #5150 on the existing list regarding the tot lot on Mountain View"Mountain View Park Area Upgrades". The tot lot on the west side of the Park. The money must be spent this spring while it is available. The money earmarked for this project is \$750,000, we want to ensure the availability of those funds.
 - 6. The comfort stations must be upgraded to ADA standards at Memorial Park.
 - 7. Stockton Street lights.
 - 8. Dennis V. Allen Park 2,000feet of sidewalks must be replaced. They are torn up by the roots of the existing trees.
 - 9. Upgrade traffic signals at 30th & Market Streets.

Committee Consensus: Continue working on CIP Recommendations at the Full Board, where there will be representatives from other neighborhoods. Keep a footnote with this Dialogue regarding the DIF fees.

99¢ Store was asked for traffic signal upon construction. Ask for traffic light there. DIF should have gone for this purpose on this site. That must be done by Council action.
