Aida Castaneda, Assemblywoman Lorena Gonzalez Office,: Assembly Member Gonzalez introduced the following Bills and both Bills were passed:

AB 1159 is intended to protect vulnerable Californians who believe they may be able to seek protection as a result of pending federal immigration reform proposals, but, instead, are already the targets of fraudulent schemes. Through specific restrictions to both lawyers and non-lawyers providing certain immigration reform services, the bill is designated to significantly reduce fraud before it occurs, as well as to provide appropriate enforcement tools to recover against those individuals who do engage in fraudulent behavior.

AND:

AB 1024- Attorneys' Right to Practice AB 1024 ensures that all individuals who meet the state law qualifications for the practice of law in California are eligible to obtain a law license regardless of their citizenship or immigration status.
