 - **a.** MB: Are there openings at this time? A: Yes always looking for candidates, reviewed procedure
- **b.** Community: Spoke on concerns about university terrace east, issues discussed were traffic, safety of pedestrians and bicycles
 - **a.** Would like to see a traffic study done
 - **b.** Community: Parking can be a concern, 80 stalls will be effected, units coming in without adequate parking
 - **c.** Six community members here from the area
 - **d.** Community: Concern that there will be a two story building next to his property
 - **e.** Luigi (Owner): Reduced number of units to 27, the City has determined that a traffic study would not be necessary. Reduced much of the buildings to two stories from three stories, adding a landscape berm. Offering rent incentive to not have a vehicle

- Architect Togawa Smith and Martin, Inc.
 - a. Project at LJVD and Genesee, empty parking lot near Costa Verde
 - **b.** Project is entitled by City Council
 - **c.** Reducing unit size to 1,290 sq ft units
 - d. Area of the project has gone down, reduction of 12% gross square feet
 - e. Tower A 16 stories, tower B23 stories tower C and D 16 stories
 - **f.** Parking is below grade down three levels
 - **g.** JB: Are you planning LEED? A: We are looking at it to see if we can get to Gold but it will be Cal Green
 - **h.** JM: So you are just designing to building code? A: Yes
 - i. PW: Are these condos or apartments? A: Right now tower A is designated as rental
 - j. LG: Can residents travel to the shopping center via the subterranean parking? A: Yes
 - k. AW: Are we looking at a bridge across Genesee? A: No
 - I. PK: Weren't there plans to connect the transit center to pedestrian arrangements?
 - **m.** JK: There are two connections to Costa Verde but they are crosswalks
 - **n.** Community: Is the project going to have public people space? A: Yes, areas described
 - **o.** AD: When does the construction start? A: Schedule is not set but activity will begin at the end of the year
 - **p.** Plan is to come back as an action item next month
 - **q.** AW: I wonder if there should be a subcommittee
