V. Potential Action Item: Planning: (6:40 p.m.)

1. **UPTOWN BIKE CORRIDOR PROJECT** – Continuation of the August 6th presentation by Beth Robraham/SANDAG regarding the draft project alignments for bicycle routes for the Uptown Regional Bike Corridor Project in Hillcrest, Mission Hills, Bankers Hill/Park West Five Points and Middletown; involves modifications to traffic flow, parking, and traffic lanes on Washington Street, University Avenue, Fourth and Fifth Avenues, India Street and other roadways in Uptown.
2. **CITY-WIDE AUTOMATED BICYCLE SHARING PROGRAM: DOWNTOWN TO BALBOA PARK** -- Bankers Hill/Park West – City Transportation Engineering – As part of Downtown component of the city-wide, automated bicycle sharing and rental program, the city is proposing to remove traffic lanes on Fourth and Fifth Avenues, from the I-5 freeway to Laurel Street, and replace with dedicated bicycle lanes.

3. **LETTER OF SUPPORT FOR HILLCREST HOE DOWN** – Hillcrest -- Event will take place on October 12, 2013, and be held on University Avenue between Vermont Street and Normal Street.

4. **LETTER OF SUPORT FOR WALK TO CURE FOR DIABETES – Hillcrest --** Event will take place on November 9, 2013, and be held along Sixth Avenue from Laurel Street to Upas Street, and in Balboa Park.
5. **LETTER OF SUPPORT FOR FOUR-WAY STOP SIGN AT THE INTERSECTION OF FIRST AVENUE AND SPRUCE STREET – Bankers Hill/Park West –** Proposal to place a four-way stop sign at the intersection of First Avenue and Spruce Street; Petitions containing 120 signatures were submitted in support of placement of the stop sign. A recommendation from Uptown Planners would provide the Third District City Councilmember the discretion to place the stop sign at the intersection.
6. **LETTER OF SUPPORT FOR FOUR-WAY STOP SIGN AT THE INTERSECTION OF FIRST AVENUE AND JUNIPER STREET – Bankers Hill/Park West –** Proposal to place a four-way stop sign at the intersection of First Avenue and Juniper Street; a recommendation from Uptown Planners would provide the Third District City Councilmember the discretion to place the stop sign at the intersection.
