## Historical Resources Board Presents Annual Awards

**SAN DIEGO** – On Thursday, May 27, 2004, the City of San Diego Historical Resources Board presented its annual Awards of Excellence for Historic Preservation. The awards were given at the Board's regular monthly hearing in celebration of National Historic Preservation Week.

The Historical Resources Board annually gives special recognition to the people and projects that most significantly reflect the best of the year in historic preservation. This year awards in eight categories were presented to the following individuals:

- **CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION** in the category of **Agency** for ensuring preservation of the historical Cabrillo Freeway in the completion of the State Route 163 Corridor Management Plan. Awards presented to **David Strickland, Martin Rosen** and **Tom Ham**.
- **DENNIS GALLEGOS**, Gallegos & Associates, in the category of **Archaeology** for outstanding work in completing the Casa de Aguirre Data Recovery Program.
- **MARSHA SEWELL** in the category of **Architecture** for the outstanding restoration of the Ginty House.
- **SUZANNE LEDEBOER** in the category of **Community History** for the preservation and documentation of historical sidewalk stamps in Normal Heights.
