POLICE ARREST SUSPECTS IN RESIDENTIAL ROBBERY

San Diego Police Department Street Gang Unit detectives have arrested three suspected gang members involved in a residential robbery in Golden Hill. The suspects were wanted in connection with a robbery that occurred at about 5 a.m. on Sunday, September 3, 2006, at a private residence located at 3372 'B' Street. The victim was accosted in his home by several males armed with a shotgun who held him against his will and demanded cash, an ATM card and the victim's PIN. The suspects fled with the victim's ATM card and cash.

On Tuesday, September 5, 2006, at about 9:30 p.m., San Diego Police Department dispatchers received a call from a female identified as Tara Greene, who said her father, Chrisha Greene, was being held and beaten by several males at a residence located at 3372 'B' Street. Patrol officers from Central Division responded to the location and confronted a male, armed with a shotgun, fleeing the residence. The suspect, identified as 18 year-old Emmanuel Martin from San Diego, was taken into custody without incident. Martin, who goes by the nickname of "Toro," has ties with a San Diego street gang. The shotgun he was carrying at the time of his arrest was recovered at the scene. Inside the residence, officers arrested two additional suspects: Jorge Treviño, 28 and his brother, Jose Trevino, 29, both associates of a Chula Vista street gang. They were not armed at the time of their arrest and were taken into custody without incident.

The investigation of this incident by Gang Unit detectives has revealed that the suspects are also responsible for the September 3rd residential robbery at the same location. They have been arrested and charged with robbery and false imprisonment.
