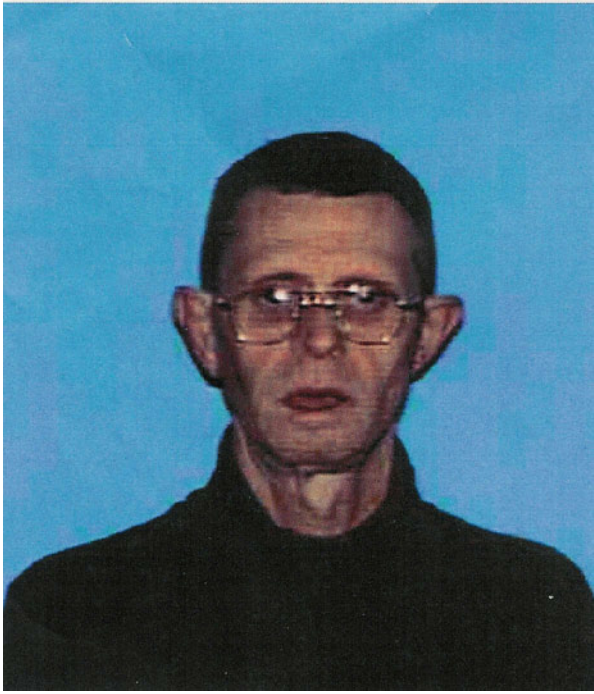
SDPD ANNOUNCES MISSING PERSON LOCATED

(San Diego) **--UPDATE--** At 1:40 p.m. on October 3, 2006, the missing man, Roy Miller, was located in a canyon near 300 W. Lewis Street. He was evaluated by the paramedics and returned to the command post to be reunited with his group.

Miller was found by the Southwest Dog Search team that was assisting in the effort to locate him. In addition to this team, SDPD had multiple units, the Air Support Unit (ABLE), motorcycle units, State Park Rangers, and Retired Senior Volunteers assisting in the search effort.

At about 5 a.m. this morning, Roy Edward Miller, 60, left the Ramada Inn at 2200 Hotel Circle South. Miller has the mental capacity of a 4-year-old. Miller is a white male, about 5' 5", 105 lbs, and was wearing a red baseball cap, a multi-colored (possibly flannel) shirt, blue jeans with the cuffs rolled up. Miller doesn't speak and cannot read. He is visiting San Diego with a group from Visalia, California. Miller was spotted at about 7 a.m. by a group of construction workers in the area of Hotel Circle.
