### **STATS FROM CHARGERS/RAIDERS GAME**

(San Diego) The SDPD had two prisoner processing centers set up at Qualcomm Stadium. A mobile police command van was set up in the parking lot and the usual prisoner processing center was operational inside the stadium. In addition to enforcement inside the stadium, there was a DUI Saturation Patrol detail in Mission Valley.

The following is a combined recap from both prisoner processing centers at the game and the DUI detail.

Forty-three arrests were made. One felony arrest for assault with great bodily injury; 27 arrests for drunk in public (8 went to Detox and 19 went to SD Central Jail); 1 warrant arrest; 1 misdemeanor cite for illegal vending in the parking lot; 2 misdemeanor cites for motor vehicle violations; 2 misdemeanor cites for possession of beer kegs; 2 misdemeanor cites for selling illegal merchandise, 5 misdemeanor cites for glass bottles and 2 misdemeanor cites for urinating in public.

Eighty people were ejected from the game primarily for fighting and alcohol related violations. Nineteen persons were cited for misuse of disabled parking placards.

During the game, two crime cases were taken, one for assault with intent to commit great bodily injury and one for misdemeanor battery.

As part of the DUI Saturation detail, five people were arrested for DUI and three vehicles were impounded.
