Detectives Seek Public's Assistance to Identify Suspects in Robbery/Shooting

Release Date: December 5, 2006

The San Diego Police Department Robbery Unit, in conjunction with the San Diego Sheriffs Office and Carlsbad Police Department, are investigating three commercial robberies that occurred on December 3, 2006.

Two suspects armed with a shotgun robbed the 7-11 convenience store at 1531 West Mission, San Marcos, the Shell Gas Station at 1145 Carlsbad Village Dr. in Carlsbad, and the Shell Gas Station at 8920 Miramar Rd., San Diego. The clerk at the Shell Gas Station on Miramar Rd. was shot by one of the suspects when the clerk did not immediately comply with the suspect's demand for cash. The suspects were seen leaving the area of one of the robberies driving a gold colored four door vehicle.

The two suspects are described as black males in their mid 20s, 5' 10" to 6' tall. One suspect is described as heavy set and the other as thin. Both suspects were described as wearing dark colored clothing. One of the suspects was described as wearing a dark blue Padres baseball cap.

Still photographs (CDs) are available at the San Diego Police Department Headquarters front desk at 1401 Broadway St. The front counter closes at 5:30 p.m. each day. The pictures are also attached to this release.
