San Diego County Crime Stoppers is joining forces with San Diego Police Department's Southern Division detectives to help identify and apprehend multiple suspects wanted for assault with a deadly weapon.

On October 28, 2006, at approximately 3:55 a.m., the adult male victim was walking on 4600 Camino de la Plaza (the bridge over the I-5 freeway near the Mexican border). The victim was approached and then assaulted by 2-4 African-American males; the suspects were also accompanied by a white female. The victim was punched and kicked in the face multiple times and suffered serious facial injuries that include a broken nose and jaw. The victim remains in the hospital and must undergo additional surgery.

Anyone with information on the identity and/or location of these suspects should call the **Crime Stoppers anonymous toll-free tip line at (888) 580-TIPS**. Crime Stoppers is offering up to a \$1,000 reward to anyone with information that leads to the arrest of these suspects.

For information leading to an arrest, you could receive up to a \$1,000 reward and remain anonymous. The qualification of any person(s) for the reward and the amount of the reward for any person(s) so qualifying will be determined by San Diego County Crime Stoppers, Inc, in its sole discretion. The amount of all rewards given shall not exceed \$1,000. Information must be received on the tip line, (888) 580-TIPS.
