On November 15, 2006, at about 11:15 am, 39-year-old Neal Brinkerhoff was stabbed in the stomach at 10800 Camino Ruiz in Mira Mesa. Brinkerhoff's pancreas, stomach and bowels were punctured in the stabbing; he remains in critical condition at a local hospital.
