

## Chula Vista Police Department Detectives Seek Public's Assistance to Help Identify Suspects in Robbery

San Diego County Crime Stoppers	Crime Stoppers is joining forces with the Chula Vista Police Department's Robbery Unit to help identify the persons responsible for a home invasion robbery that occurred at 2164 Dutchman Court in Chula Vista.
Law Enforcement Liaison Office 1401 Broadway San Diego, CA 92101	On October 13, 2006, at about 10:20 p.m., two men, one of them armed with a handgun, entered a residence occupied by two men and two women. The armed suspects demanded money, jewelry and bank card personal identification numbers (PIN).
	The two suspects "pistol whipped" the male victims causing a head laceration to one of them which required medical attention. The female victims were not injured.
<b>TIPLINE</b> (888) 580-TIPS	Suspect #1 was described as approximately 26 years old, 6'2" tall, and 170 lbs. wearing a blue knit ski hat over his face. He was also armed with a black handgun.
	Suspect #2 was described as a Hispanic male in his early 20's, 5'9" tall, 190 lbs. and wearing a black hooded sweatshirt, blue jeans and white
