SUSPECT IN COMMERCIAL BURGLARY CASE SOUGHT (VIDEO AVAILABLE)

(San Diego) Detectives from the San Diego Police Department's Northeastern Division are releasing video of a suspect in a commercial burglary case in the hopes that someone can assist us in identifying him.

The Collins Family Jewelry store, located at 8220 Mira Mesa Blvd. was burglarized at about 6:30 a.m. on September 12, 2007. The suspect got into the business by smashing the front glass door. The suspect took jewelry valued at approximately \$20,000. The suspect appears to be a black male, shorter than average height, with a bald head or very short haircut and was carrying a red backpack.

Crime Stoppers is offering up to a \$1,000 reward to anyone with information that leads to the arrest of this suspect. Collect calls are accepted and callers may remain anonymous.
