On February 04, 2007, David Griffis walked away from McCain Valley Sierra Conservation Center which is a correctional camp located in Boulevard, CA. He was incarcerated in March, 2006 and was serving a six year prison sentence for a criminal offense. David Griffis is a white male with brown eyes, a shaved head and may be clean shaven. He has several tattoos. The name "Shelly" is tattooed on his neck and upper back. He also has a cartoon character and the word "hate" on his neck. David Griffis is currently being sought in the areas of San Diego.

David Kevin Griffis also uses the name Bryce Brian Griffis. He is a 40 year old white male about 5'9" tall and weighs about 190 lbs. He has brown eyes, a shaved head and may be clean shaven. Griffis has several tattoos. The name "Shelly" is tattooed on his neck and upper back. He also has a cartoon character and the word "hate" on his neck.
