Auto Theft Suspect Sought

San Diego County Crime Stoppers, along with San Diego Police Department Northeastern detectives, are seeking the public's assistance to help locate a suspect wanted for two felony warrants.

Detectives said Robert Lee Gwin has an outstanding \$100,000 felony warrant for attempted auto theft, and an outstanding \$15,000 drug warrant. Gwin is on probation for attempted auto theft and has been convicted of various felony and misdemeanor property crimes.

Gwin was last seen on April 3, 2007 in the area of 8900 Newmont Drive. In this most recent case, Gwin is suspected of stealing a credit card reader, more than forty credit cards, three computer servers, cell phones, cameras, two cars and various other items.

Gwin is described as a white male, 5'5" tall, 160lbs, with brown hair and brown eyes (see attached photo).

Anyone with information on Gwin is encouraged to call Northeastern Division at (858) 538-8000, or you can remain anonymous by calling Crime Stoppers toll-free tip line at **(888) 580-TIPS**. You could be eligible for a reward of up to \$1,000 for information leading to the arrest of Robert Gwin.
