SDPD SEEKS BANK ROBBERY SUSPECT

(San Diego) San Diego Police Robbery Unit detectives are investigating a robbery of the Mission Federal Credit Union at 675 Saturn Boulevard in the Nestor community.

On January 12, 2007 at about 12:25 p.m., a male robbed the credit union of an undisclosed amount of cash.

The suspect is described as a black male, 25-35 years old, approximately 5'11" to 6'1" tall. The suspect was wearing a grayish beanie cap, large sunglasses, a gray jacket and blue jeans. He was carrying a burgundy and gray backpack. Two photos of the suspect are attached to this release.


