## **NORTHWESTERN DIVISION TO HOST COMMUNITY OPEN HOUSE**

**(San Diego)** Mayor Jerry Sanders, Council President Scott Peters and Chief William Lansdowne invite all members of the community to the San Diego Police Department's Northwestern Division Open House. The event will take place on Saturday, October 20, 2007 from 10 a.m. to noon.

The Northwestern Division station is located at 12592 El Camino Real in Carmel Valley. Tours of the new station will be available as well as a demonstration by the K-9 Unit and static displays.

Construction on this project began in January 2005 and the station became operational on March 10, 2007. The project was funded solely by Facilities Benefit Assessment (FBA) funds at a total cost of \$19.1 million. The contractor on this project was T.B. Penick and the architects were Jeff Katz and Safdie Rabines.

Northwestern Division consists of more than 21-thousand square feet of space. The property also houses a 5-thousand square foot vehicle maintenance facility, a car wash, a fueling station and an emergency generator.

The station serves the following communities: Black Mountain Ranch, Torrey Highlands, Torrey Preserve, Carmel Valley, Sorrento Valley, Del Mar Heights and North City.
