### **PEDESTRIAN ROBBERY SERIES IN NORTHEASTERN DIVISION**

(San Diego) San Diego Police Department Northeastern Division detectives are working several pedestrian (street) robbery cases that began in February of this year. There have been nine cases thus far and all but two of the cases occurred after 10 p.m.

The pedestrian robberies occurred at the following locations: 10800 and 10900 Gerana Street, 14300 and 14400 Gerona Court, 14400 Val Verde Court, 10800 Monsanto Court, 10800 Carmel Mountain Road, 10700 Caminata Deluz and 13000 Via Rimini.

There are three suspects associated with this series but the suspect descriptions are minimal. In three of the cases a gun was used. The suspects are targeting the victims when they are returning home to their apartments. The suspect either grabs the victim's purse or threatens the victim with a gun and takes the purse.

Citizens are advised to:

- Park in well lighted areas and try to have someone walk you from your car to your door
- Be aware of your surroundings
- Carry your cell phone with you in case you need to call for help but don't talk on your phone while walking alone
- Trust your instincts
