SDPD SEEKS BANK ROBBERY SUSPECT

(San Diego) San Diego Police Robbery Unit detectives are investigating the robbery of the Washington Mutual Bank at 1740 Rosecrans Street.

On March 24, 2007 at about 11:20 a.m., a male robbed the Washington Mutual Bank of an undisclosed amount of cash.

The suspect is described as a dark-skinned black male, 35-40 years old, approximately 6' to 6'1" tall, 190-200 pounds. The suspect was wearing a blue baseball cap with a white logo and piping, a two-tone black pullover sweater, blue pants and tan sandals. He displayed a large framed semi-automatic pistol in his waistband. Several photos of the suspect are attached to this news release and a CD-Rom version of the photos is available at the SDPD headquarters front counter until 5 p.m. today.

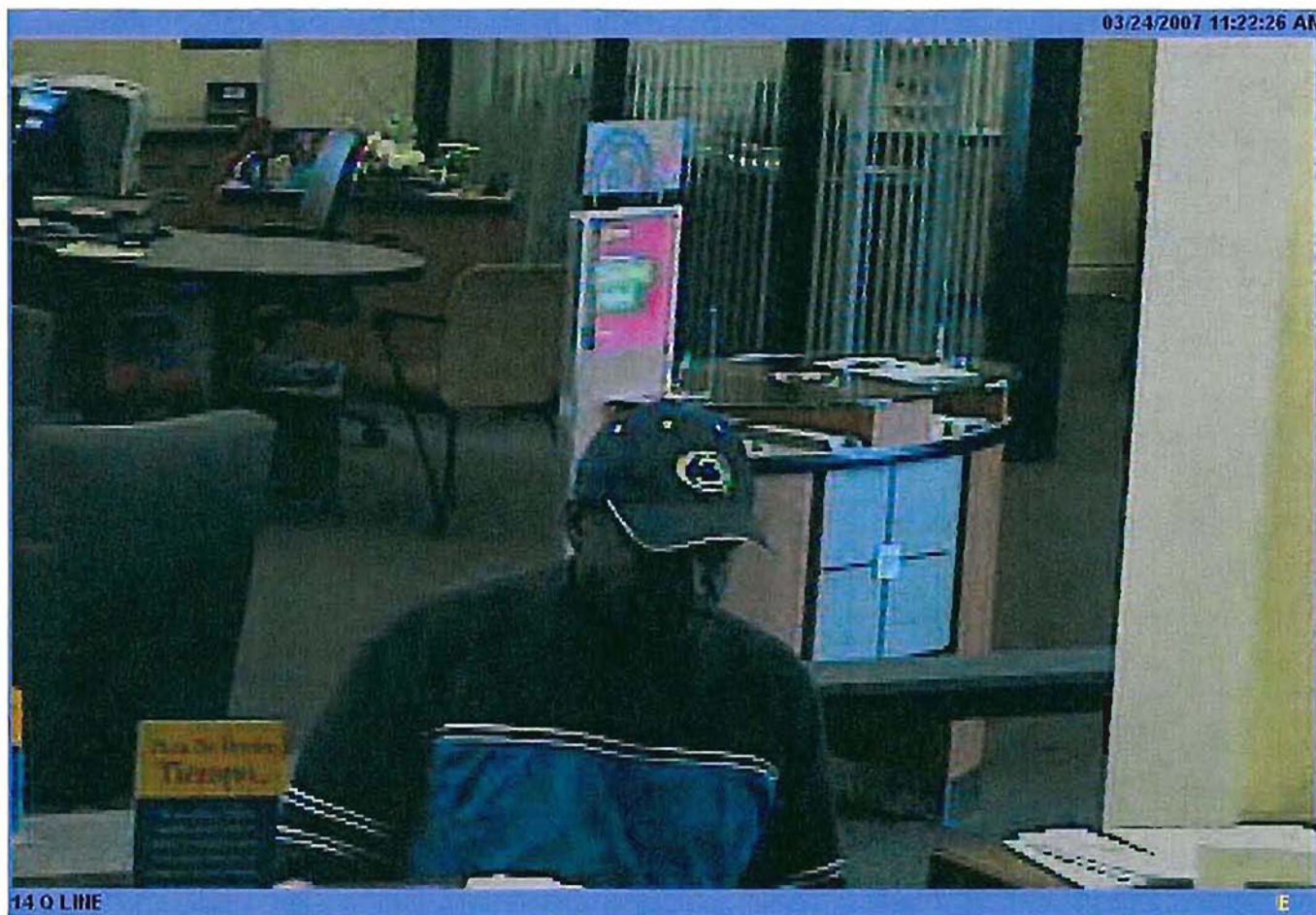
