TWO BODIES DISCOVERED INSIDE SKYLINE DUPLEX

San Diego Police Department Homicide Unit detectives are investigating the discovery of two deceased males inside a Skyline duplex this afternoon. The males were found inside a one-bedroom residence in the 300 block of Woodman Street.

The resident of the unit, a 70-year-old male, has been at a local hospital for the past week. The resident called two relatives and asked them to visit his home to check on it and to pick up some personal items. At approximately 1:00 p.m., the relatives went to the home and found the front door open. They entered and found the living room ransacked. While checking the rest of the home, they found two males in separate rooms who appeared to be deceased. Officers responded to the home and confirmed the males were dead.

Detectives obtained a search warrant to enter the residence, and they have just begun the process of documenting and collecting evidence. The victims appear to have trauma to their bodies, but the source of their injuries (e.g. blunt force, gunshot) is not known. The victims are currently unidentified.

The resident's vehicle, a light blue, 1987 Dodge Caravan bearing California Disabled license plate DPD8476, is missing. Anyone with information about the vehicle or this incident is encouraged to call the Homicide Unit at (619) 531-2293 or Crime Stoppers at (888) 580-TIPS.
