Robbery Suspects Caught on Tape \$1,000 Reward Offered

San Diego County Crime Stoppers is joining forces with the San Diego Police Department Robbery unit to help identify and apprehend two suspects responsible for robbing a Chevron gas station in the Del Mar area of San Diego.

Detectives said at around 3:20 a.m. today (8-8-08) a Hispanic male and female robbed the Chevron gas station located in the 2600 block of Via De La Valle. The male suspect was armed with a shotgun and the female was armed with a handgun. Both suspects threatened the clerk and a delivery driver who happened to be making a delivery at the time of the robbery. The suspects left with an undisclosed amount of cash in a newer model silver Ford Explorer Sport Trac (4 door.)

Suspect descriptions:

- #1 Suspect: Hispanic male, mid 20's, 5'8"-5'9" tall, medium build with brown hair. He wore a long sleeve hoodie sweatshirt, grey t-shirt, light colored plaid shorts and white shoes.
- #2 Suspect: Hispanic female, mid 20's, 5'5"-5'8" tall, medium build with brown hair. She wore a white t-shirt with a light colored mini-dress.
- Suspect Vehicle: Newer model Silver colored Ford Explorer Sport Trac (4-door) with a German Shepard in the bed of the truck.

Detectives are asking anyone with information on the identity and location of these suspects to call the **Crime Stoppers anonymous tip line at (888) 580-TIPS**. Crime Stoppers is offering up to a \$1,000 reward to anyone with information that leads to the arrest of the persons responsible for this crime.
