Robbery Suspect Caught on Tape Up to a \$1,000 Reward Offered

December 19, 2008

San Diego County Crime Stoppers is joining forces with the San Diego Police Department's Robbery Unit to help identify and apprehend a suspect who robbed the El Maguey Restaurant in Mira Mesa on December 16, 2008.

Detectives say that at about 10 p.m. on December 16, 2008, a male suspect entered the business through the front door and pointed a handgun at the employee behind the counter. The suspect demanded cash and after taking money from the victim; left the business immediately. He was inside the store for less than a minute.

The suspect is described as a black adult male, early to mid twenties, 5' 8" to 5' 10" tall, thin build, clean-shaven, with wire-rimmed prescription glasses, a black beanie cap rolled up at the ends, and a gray sweat jacket with white long sleeves that had lettering across the chest and a logo on the left breast. He wore black baggy pants and black sneakers with white soles. The tail of a white shirt could be seen hanging out from under his jacket.

A CD-Rom which includes video of the suspect is available at the SDPD headquarters front counter, 1401 Broadway until 5 p.m.

Detectives are asking anyone with information on the identity and location of the suspect to call the **Crime Stoppers anonymous tip line at (888) 580-8477**. Crime Stoppers is offering up to a \$1,000 reward to anyone with information that leads to the arrest of the person responsible for this crime.
