- **Ron Harnish Murder:** This is an unsolved murder that occurred on December 27, 2006 near 1100 30th Street. Harnish, who was in the Navy, had just been accepted into the Navy Seal program. Harnish was a decorated high school football player, and was inducted into the Lakewood, CA Hall of Fame for his wrestling achievements. Harnish also wrote poetry and was published in his high school poetry publication. The Crime Stoppers reward has been increased to \$5,500 for anyone with information that leads to the arrest of the person(s) responsible for this crime. **Tracy Wild (Ron's mother) will be available for interviews after the luncheon.**
