Grab-N-Run Jewelry Thief Wanted Surveillance Photos Attached

Up to a \$1,000 Reward

San Diego County Crime Stoppers and the Escondido Police Department are joining forces to identify and locate an unidentified suspect wanted for stealing jewelry from high-end jewelry stores in San Diego and Orange Counties.

All of the incidents have taken place at shopping malls. The suspect is described as well-dressed and articulate. He will look at merchandise, primarily loose stones, until the store is clear of customers and then steal the merchandise. Surveillance photos of the suspect are included on page two of this news release.

Suspect description: Suspect is described as a Black, male, about 25-30 years old, about 5'11 tall, with short brown hair, and hazel eyes.
