Guy Lofton III Murder Remains Unsolved One Year Later

San Diego County Crime Stoppers is joining forces with the San Diego Police Department's Homicide Unit to help identify the suspect(s) wanted for the murder of Guy Christopher Lofton III.

It has been one year since Guy Lofton III was murdered and his family is still mourning his death. On October 28, 2007 at about 1:20 a.m., 17-yearold Guy Christopher Lofton III was found lying on the sidewalk at 2300 Commercial Street in San Diego. Guy had suffered a gunshot wound and died from his injuries. His murder remains unsolved.

At 1:30 p.m. today, Guy Lofton III's family will gather at the corner of 25th and Commercial Street for a candlelight vigil. They will also make themselves available for the media.

Family members would like to keep this story in the news in hopes that someone who knows something about this case will call SDPD or Crime Stoppers.
