Why: Sadly, San Diego County Law Enforcement lost two United States Border Patrol officers this year. Agents Jarod Dittman and Eric Cabral both died in the line of duty during different interactions. Agent Dittman leaves behind his wife and daughter. Agent Cabral, a San Diego native, is survived by his parents and sisters.

This service also recognizes the men and women currently serving in law enforcement. Hundreds of law enforcement professionals will be in attendance, along with the surviving family members of many of the fallen officers.

Organizers extend an invitation to all citizens of San Diego County to attend this very moving service. It is an opportunity to show your support for the people of local law enforcement and the sacrifices they make to keep our streets safe.

The event is hosted by the San Diego County Law Enforcement Memorial Foundation, in cooperation with the San Diego Crime Commission, the San Diego County Police Chiefs' and Sheriff's Association, and the Peace Officers Research Association of California – San Diego/Imperial Counties Chapter.
