**Suspect Wanted for Indecent Exposure - Series Related**  
(Surveillance Video Available)

**\$1,000 Reward Offered**

Release Date: Thursday, July 10, 2008

San Diego County Crime Stoppers, working with San Diego Police Department Mid-City Detectives, is asking for the public's assistance to help identify a suspect wanted for multiple cases of indecent exposure.

Detectives said between September 2007 and June 2008, the suspect may be responsible for at least eight separate incidents of indecent exposure. The suspect, who is bilingual, frequents coin laundries and apartment buildings in the Mid-City, Southeastern, and Central areas of San Diego. The suspect targets Hispanic females and once eye contact is made, he exposes himself and masturbates.

The suspect is described as a Black male but may be Cuban or Puerto Rican with a dark complexion. He has a tattoo on the right side of his neck and on both arms with lettering on the right. His hairstyle changes from thick braids to popcorn twists to afro and he may have earrings in both ears. He usually wears an oversized white tee shirt, either black or gray (¾ length) over sized shorts and black Chuck Taylor converse shoes.
