Ocean Beach Vandalism Suspect Sought Up to \$1,000 Reward Offered

Friday - September 19, 2008

San Diego County Crime Stoppers, working with San Diego Police Western Division detectives, is asking for assistance from the public in identifying and locating a suspect wanted for over 130 vehicle vandalism cases.

Detectives said on June 19-20, 2008, over 30 vehicles parked on the street in the Ocean Beach area were sprayed with an unidentified bluish colored liquid. The vandalism occurred sometime in the middle of the night.

On September 12-13, 2008, there were over 100 vehicles sprayed with a similar colored liquid. This damage also occurred sometime in the middle of the night on the same streets in the Ocean Beach area.

The liquid in both cases is believed to be an ink product that causes permanent paint damage to most cars.

Anyone with information on the identity or location of the suspect(s) is asked to call the **Crime Stoppers anonymous toll-free tip line at (888) 580-TIPS**. Crime Stoppers is offering up to a **\$1,000** reward to anyone with information that leads to the arrest of the person responsible for these vandalisms.

For information leading to an arrest, you could receive up to a \$1,000 reward and remain anonymous. The qualification of any person(s) for the reward and the amount of the reward for any person(s) so qualifying will be determined by San Diego County Crime Stoppers, Inc. in its sole discretion.
