Detectives Release Names and Photos of Suspects in O.B. Attempt Homicide

**BOTH SUSPECTS ARRESTED ON
3/31/08**

San Diego County Crime Stoppers, working with San Diego Police Western Division detectives, is seeking any information regarding the location of two suspects wanted for attempt homicide.

On February 27, 2008, at about 5:20 a.m., 26-year-old Robert Schneider was at a fire ring, on the sand, near the main Lifeguard Station (1950 Abbott Street) in Ocean Beach. Schneider got into an argument with two men (suspects.) The argument escalated and the two suspects beat Schneider with a skateboard. After the beating, the suspects threw Schneider into the fire. Schneider received serious injuries to his body and head from the skateboard as well as 2nd and 3rd degree burns from the fire. Since the incident, Schneider has remained at the hospital in a coma. Both suspects fled the scene after the incident.

Detectives have now identified both suspects wanted for this attempt homicide.

Suspect #1: Frank Montoya, D.O.B. 04/06/1961, Hispanic male, 5'5" tall, about 160 lbs. with brown hair and brown eyes.

Suspect #2: Damian Maple, D.O.B. 08/11/1986, White male, 6'2" tall, about 185 lbs. with brown hair and blue eyes.

Anyone with any information on the location of these suspects is asked to call the **Crime Stoppers anonymous tip line at (888) 580-TIPS**. Crime Stoppers is offering up to a \$1,000 reward to anyone with information that leads to a felony arrest.
