San Diego County Crime Stoppers, working with the San Diego Police Department's Homicide Unit, is seeking information on a homicide that occurred in the Skyline area of San Diego.

On March 31, 2008, at about 11:30 p.m., a group of males and females were entering a store in the 6800 block of Imperial Avenue when they were confronted by at least three males. One of the males, described as Hispanic, 17-22, 5'6"-5'8" 120-140 pounds, wearing a light-colored hooded sweatshirt with a design on the front, light-colored pants, and dark gloves on his hands pulled out a handgun and shot at the victims. Three people were struck by gunfire, and 19-year-old Ramon Rivera was killed.
