## Suspect Sought by Economic Crimes Unit for Theft of Credit Card - Surveillance Photo Attached

**Up to a \$1,000 Reward**

**San Diego County Crime Stoppers** is joining forces with the San Diego Police Department's Economic Crimes Unit to identify and locate an unidentified female for theft of a credit card.

In February 2008 an unknown female used a stolen credit and debit card at a store in the College Grove area of San Diego charging nearly \$1000 dollars in merchandise. Surveillance video of the suspect was obtained from the store where the suspect used the stolen card.

Suspect description: Hispanic female, between 19-23 years old. She has long dark hair and a heavy build.
