Robbery Suspect Sought

Up to \$1,000 Reward Offered

San Diego County Crime Stoppers is joining forces with the San Diego Police Department's Robbery Unit to help apprehend the suspect responsible for several commercial robberies that have occurred in August and September.

The suspect enters the business and shops for a period of time. He takes items to the register and then gives the clerk a demand note. He says he has a gun, but no gun has been seen. He takes merchandise and cash. No one has been injured in any case. No vehicle has been seen by witnesses.

Suspect description:

- Black male, 40-50, 6'2" – 6'6" 210-230 lbs. with black hair and possibly a thin moustache. He wears a baseball cap and black sunglasses in every case.
