Robbery Suspect Sought

Up to \$1,000 Reward Offered

San Diego County Crime Stoppers is joining forces with the San Diego Police Department's Robbery Unit to help apprehend the suspect responsible for a robbery that occurred at the Walgreen's North Park.

On September 30, 2009 the suspect entered the Walgreen's at 3200 University Avenue and approached the employee behind the counter with items as if he was going to make a purchase. When the employee rang up the items, the suspect demanded cash and put his hand under his shirt as if he had a handgun. No weapon was seen. After getting cash from the employee, the suspect fled on foot. No vehicle was seen by witnesses.

Suspect description:

- Black male, 35 - 40, 5'10" to 6', 170 - 190 lbs. He had dark skin, short grayish hair, a thin moustache, and white reading-type glasses. He wore a gray sweater with green stripes around the collar and black dress pants.

Detectives are asking anyone with information on the identity of this suspect to call the **Crime Stoppers anonymous tip line at (888) 580-8477**.
