## 14-Year-Old Abducted and Sexually Assaulted Near Chicano Park; Detectives Looking for Unidentified Suspects

### \$1,000 Reward

Release Date: March 26, 2009

San Diego County Crime Stoppers, working with San Diego Police Department Central Division detectives, is seeking any information regarding two unidentified male suspects wanted for the kidnap and sexual assault of a juvenile.

On February 27, 2009, at approximately 3:00 p.m., a 14-year-old girl was abducted as she walked home from school through Chicano Park. The victim was forced into a truck and then blindfolded. The victim was driven to a house at an unknown location and sexually assaulted. At approximately 7:45 p.m., the victim was driven to 3300 National Avenue and released. The victim did not know the suspects.

Suspect Descriptions: Both suspects were described as Hispanic males, mid 30's, 5'6" to 5'8"; one of the suspects had a small scar by his eye.

Suspect Vehicle: Dark blue (2-door) older square style pick-up with a king cab, listed with big tires and a loud mussler. The truck was dirty, with a small round white sticker on the passenger window and a chrome rear bumper; it did not have plates at the time.

Anyone with any information on the identity and location of these two suspects is asked to call the Crime Stoppers anonymous tip line at (888) 580-8477. Crime Stoppers is offering up to a \$1,000 reward to anyone with information that leads to a felony arrest.
