Chula Vista PD Looking To Identify Car Thief; Suspect Caught on Surveillance Video Up to \$1,000 Reward Offered

San Diego County Crime Stoppers is joining forces with the Chula Vista Police Department to help identify and apprehend the suspect responsible for a recent car theft.

Investigators said on October 20, 2009, around mid-morning, an unknown suspect stole a 2004 Jeep Liberty from a parking lot on the 600 block of L Street in Chula Vista, CA. The vehicle was parked near the vehicle owners business. The vehicle was located unoccupied on October 24, 2009 in the 600 block of F Street in Chula Vista, CA.

The suspect has not been identified but was captured by a very clear surveillance camera located within the victim's business. The suspect is seen walking into the victim's place of business to have his laptop computer repaired. While the victim was helping the suspect, the suspect can be seen stealing the owner's car keys which were left on the business counter. A short time later, the suspect is seen driving away in the victim's car.

A copy of the surveillance video can be picked up from the SDPD headquarters front counter until 5 p.m. A picture of the suspect is attached to page two of this release.

Investigators are asking anyone with information on the identity of the person responsible for this crime to call the **Crime Stoppers anonymous tip line at (888) 580-8477**. Crime Stoppers is offering up to a \$1,000 reward to anyone with information that leads to an arrest. Anonymous email and text messages can be sent in via www.sdcrimestoppers.com.
