POLICE INVESTIGATE MURDER IN MIRA MESA NEIGHBORHOOD

(San Diego) San Diego Police Department Homicide Unit detectives are investigating the shooting death of a 29-year-old male which occurred yesterday at about 10:00 p.m.

On December 31, 2008, at about 10:00 p.m., patrol officers received a radio call of a male armed with a handgun in the 7600 block of Dancy Road. Upon their arrival, they found a male victim in the street suffering from an apparent gunshot wound. Citizens as well as responding emergency personnel attempted life saving measures however the victim was pronounced dead at the scene at about 10:15 p.m.

The preliminary investigation has revealed that the murder suspect is described as approximately 30 years old, 5'6" tall, with a "spiked" hairstyle. He was in the company of several companions, when they confronted another group of males on the front porch of a residence on Dancy Road. The two groups began to argue at which point the described suspect fired a single shot at the victim, striking him in the torso area. The victim has been identified as Andy Ho, a resident of San Diego. After the shooting, the suspects fled the area westbound on Dancy Road. The motivation for the attack is not known at this point. Detectives are interviewing several potential witnesses in an effort to determine the circumstances that led to the shooting death of Mr. Ho.
