Burglary Suspect Caught on Surveillance Camera \$1,000 Reward

San Diego County Crime Stoppers, working with San Diego Police Department Northeastern Division detectives, is seeking any information regarding an unidentified male suspect wanted for burglary.

On January 1, 2009, at about 5:00 p.m., an unknown suspect pried-open the back door to Frog's Gym at 12171 World Trade Drive in Carmel Mountain Ranch. The suspect entered the building and took the keys to the business. The suspect left the business and returned a short time later taking two computers, a cash box, and a necklace. The suspect was in and out of the business numerous times for approximately three hours. While the suspect was in the business, he was captured on surveillance cameras.

The suspect is described as:

White or Asian male in his late thirties or early forties. He has a stocky build and distinctive male pattern baldness.
