## Two Suspects Wanted in Assault with a Deadly Weapon Case

# \$1,000 Reward

Release Date: April 3, 2009

San Diego County Crime Stoppers, working with San Diego County Sheriff's Department Lemon Grove detectives, is seeking any information regarding two unidentified male suspects wanted for assault with a deadly weapon.

Detectives said on March 27, 2009, at about 4:34 a.m., two black males (approximately 18-25, med. height and build) went to the 'Villas Casa De Oro' apartment complex located at 3860 Helix St. in Spring Valley. The subjects attempted to contact someone at one of the apartments and then suddenly opened fire into the front door of the apartment. One subject was armed with a handgun and one was armed with a rifle. Numerous rounds were fired through the closed door into the apartment. An 8 year old boy was struck by a bullet as he was sleeping in an adjacent bedroom. His injuries are not life threatening.

Anyone with any information on the identity and location of these suspects is asked to call the **Crime Stoppers anonymous tip line at (888) 580-8477.** Crime Stoppers is offering up to a \$1,000 reward to anyone with information that leads to a felony arrest.
