UPDATE: On 12/26/09 at about 6 p.m., Roger B. Jones (7/29/65) was arrested when he crossed the border from Tijuana into San Diego. He has been identified as the “Long Jaw” robbery suspect. Jones is currently being held in the SD Central Jail. He is believed responsible for nearly 30 commercial robberies around the county of San Diego.

Working in conjunction with the San Diego Police Department, Crime Stoppers is seeking to identify and apprehend the suspect responsible for several robberies in San Diego since August.
