BURGLARY SUSPECT ARRESTED

(San Diego) San Diego Police Department Western Division announces the arrest of 22-year-old Ernesto Hernandez Robles; believed responsible for several burglary cases.

During August and September several homes in the Mission Hills area were burglarized. The suspect would enter these homes through unlocked doors and windows during the day – most often when residents were home. The suspect stole a variety of items including: computers, jewelry, a television, Ipods and car keys. In four cases he stole the homeowner's car and in three of those instances the stolen cars crossed the border into Tijuana, Mexico.

On September 10, 2009 Western Division officers received a call from a resident on Plumosa Way regarding a prowler; officers and detectives who were in the area responded to the call. Robles was detained and identified by the homeowner as the person who was prowling around her home.

Robles is believed responsible for as many as 10 hot prowl burglary cases that have occurred in Mission Hills. He was booked into San Diego Central Jail on one count of first degree burglary and one count of prowling. Further investigation is underway in order to link Robles with the other cases.
