“This Ain’t No Joke” Robbery Series Suspect Sought

San Diego County Crime Stoppers, working with the San Diego Police Department’s Robbery Unit seek the public’s assistance to help identify the suspect(s) in a robbery series dubbed “This Ain’t No Joke.”

The suspect may be responsible for up to five robbery cases that have occurred since Sunday, March 29, 2009. The suspect enters the business and demands cash from the register and safe. He uses phrases similar to “This ain’t no joke, I’m serious, this is a robbery.” No weapon has been seen or mentioned in these cases.

The suspect is described as a black male in his 20s, 5’5” to 6’ tall, between 150 and 200 lbs. He has been seen wearing braids in his hair or wearing a cap or bandana over his hair.

March 29, 2009 – 4600 Mission Blvd. – Cold Stone Creamery
April 5, 2009 – 10700 Westview Parkway – Cold Stone Creamery
April 5, 2009 – 3700 Fourth Avenue – Pinkberry
April 5, 2009 – 8800 Villa La Jolla – TF Yogurt
