Unidentified Burglar Gets Stuck in Ceiling; Surveillance Video Released

Reward of up to \$1,000

Release Date: December 3, 2009

San Diego County Crime Stoppers is joining forces with the San Diego Police Department's Western Division detectives to help identify and apprehend a suspect wanted for burglary.

Detectives said between October 19, 2009 at 4 p.m. and October 20, 2009 at 6:30 a.m. an unknown suspect burglarized the former North Park Inn at 2625 University Avenue; the building is currently under construction. Onsite surveillance video captured the suspect climbing through the ceiling into the construction office. In the video, the suspect appears to get stuck in the ceiling as he attempts to gain entry into the construction office; he eventually frees himself and falls to the ground.

The suspect is described as an adult Black male, wearing a light colored sweatshirt, dark pants with a light colored stripe running across the back and down both legs and white sneakers.
