San Diego County Crime Stoppers is joining forces with the San Diego Police Department Robbery Unit to help identify and apprehend the suspect responsible for robbing a 7-Eleven Store in North Park.

*Detectives said on June 17, 2009, at about 3:35 a.m., a male suspect robbed the 7-Eleven Store in the 3000 block of Meade Avenue. The suspect indicated he was armed but no gun was seen. The store clerk was not injured in the incident. The suspect left with an undisclosed amount of cash. Suspect descriptions:

- Suspect: White male, mid 20s-30s, about 6'4" tall, thin build, brown hair and blue eyes. Tattoo of a cross or dagger on his inner right forearm.
- Suspect Vehicle: White Chevy Suburban with oversized rims.

Detectives are asking anyone with information on the identity and location of this suspect to call the **Crime Stoppers anonymous tip line at (888) 580-8477**. Crime Stoppers is offering up to a \$1,000 reward to anyone with information that leads to the arrest of the persons responsible for this crime.
