SUSPECT ARRESTED FOR SWAN CANYON MURDER

(**San Diego**) On December 10, 2009, at approximately 12:12 p.m., patrol officers received a radio call of a shooting in the 3200 block of Fairmount Avenue. Mid City patrol officers arrived on-scene and found Devin Lamarr Johnson suffering from gunshot wounds. He was transported to a trauma hospital, where he died the following day.

The suspect in the murder was determined to be Samuel Alexander Webster. Webster fled the scene after the shooting and detectives were unable to locate him.

San Diego Police Department Homicide Unit detectives were notified this morning of the arrest of Webster in Ventura County. Webster was arrested by agents of the San Diego County Regional Fugitive Task Force and United States Marshals Service as he left a motel early this morning in Camarillo, California. Webster was transported back to San Diego where he was booked into the San Diego Central Jail on one count of murder.
