Filirican Torres Suspicious Death Remains a Mystery; Family and Friends Gather for Victim's 27th Birthday

San Diego County Crime Stoppers, working with the San Diego Police Department's Homicide Unit, continue to seek the public's assistance to help answer the questions surrounding the suspicious death of Filirican Torres.

On January 10, 2007, Filirican Torres was last seen at about 4:05 p.m. at the bus stop located at Fairmont Avenue and Redwood Street. It is unknown whether she got on the bus or was picked up at that time. Her intention was to ride the #13 bus to the Euclid Avenue Trolley stop. It is believed she was picked up at some point by an unknown person driving a 1992 Geo Metro (see attached picture.) Torres was struck by several vehicles at about 5:30 p.m. on Eastbound SR94 near Euclid Avenue. It is unknown whether she was pushed or fell from the vehicle.

At 1:00 p.m. today, Filirican Torres' family and friends will be available for media interviews in room 213 at the San Diego Police Department Headquarters, 1401 Broadway, San Diego.
