- What:** Recommendations for residents of Tijuana River Valley
- Where:** Southern Division, Tijuana River Valley
All of Monument Road, Saturn Blvd. south of Leon, Hollister south of Tocayo, and Dairy Mart Road south of Camino de la Plaza
- Why:** Heavy rains are expected to occur this week. The Tijuana River Valley area is one which floods on a regular basis.

The first storm is expected early Monday morning and is expected to drop up to two inches of rain through Tuesday.

The second storm is expected to be even larger and could potentially drop up to 1 inch per hour beginning late Thursday, lasting through Friday.

SDPD recommends residents and those who keep horses in the area take this opportunity to move their families and animals to higher ground. It would be preferable if these arrangements are made prior to the arrival of the impending storms. Streets in the area will likely be closed during the rains which will make any travel in and out of the area much more difficult.
