



Unidentified Suspects Sought For Grand Theft

Up to \$1,000 Reward Offered

San Diego County Crime Stoppers and Investigators from the San Diego Police Department's Central Division are asking for assistance from the public in identifying two suspects wanted for grand theft.

Investigators said on March 16th 2010, two unknown male suspects entered several businesses along 2100-2500 Imperial Avenue selling (door-to-door) solar lights and Tupperware. The suspects entered a store at 2150 Imperial Avenue in an attempt to sell their products to the clerk. After the store clerk refused to purchase anything, the suspects grabbed a good luck charm doll that had a 14K gold necklace and money pinned to it from the store counter. The suspects fled the scene in a white Ford Explorer.

Suspect #1: Black male, about 20-25 years-old, approximately 6' tall with a thin build, black hair and brown eyes. He was wearing a blue long sleeve shirt and dress slacks.

Suspect #2: Black male, about 18-20 years-old, approximately 5'10" tall with a thin build, black hair and brown eyes. He was wearing a peach colored long sleeve shirt and dress slacks.

Pictures of both suspects were captured by surveillance video. The pictures are attached to this release.

Investigators are asking anyone with information on the identity and or location of the persons responsible for this crime to call SDPD Central Division at (619) 744-9500 or the **Crime Stoppers anonymous tip line at (888) 580-8477**. Crime Stoppers is offering up to a \$1,000 reward to anyone with information that leads to an arrest in this case. Anonymous email and text messages can be sent in via www.sdcrimestoppers.com.
